Itinerary:

Day 1: Fly to Las Vegas, NV - Arrival Day

September 24, 2027 (Friday)

You will depart this morning for Las Vegas, NV. Plan to arrive at the Las Vegas, NV well before 2:00 pm. A charter bus will pick up guests and their luggage at the airport at 3:00 pm. Then we will make the drive from NV to St. George, UT and arrive at our hotel for a meet and greet dinner with the tour leader. Guests may attend the St. George Temple on their own this evening. Hotel: Hyatt Place Hotel/ St. George

Day 2: St. George Visitor's Center/ Snow Canyon/ Tuacahn Theater

September 25, 2027 (Saturday)

We will spend the day seeing the sites in St. George, Utah. Our stops include the St. George Visitors Center and Tabernacle, St. George old downtown, Snow Canyon, and Veyo, Utah for handmade pies. In the evening, we will attend the acclaimed Tuacahn Theater for a musical play. Meals : Breakfast, Dinner- Veyo, Utah. Hotel: Hyatt Place Hotel/ St. George

Day 3: Pine Valley Ward & St. George LDS Sites

September 26, 2027 (Sunday)

We will then travel to Temple Quarry hike, a short 1.2 mile RT hike to see where the pioneers quarried the stones for the temple. Day 4: Zion National Park

September 27, 2027 (Monday)

Today we head out to spend the day in the amazing Zion's National Park. We will arrive early at the Park, then guests will be on their own to take shuttles and see beautiful vistas and take hikes, if they like. If hiking isn't your thing, there is much to do at the Zion Park Visitors Center and there is a Tram, for a fee, to see the landscape. Meals : Breakfast, Dinner at a group. Day 5: Bryce Canyon National Park

September 28, 2027 (Tuesday)

Another epic day visiting Utah's beautiful scenery and landscapes in the desert. Today we will enter Bryce Canyon National Park as a group on the bus and tour together, making stops along the way. Day 6: BYU Campus/Provo, UT

This is a bucket list location and we will have a private tour and lecture showing original Book of Mormon's, King James Bibles, original scriptures from Spencer W. There is also a train to take you to each site while you visit working shops, barns with animals, and even a ship showing how the pioneers crossed the Atlantic. Day 8: Salt Lake Temple Open House Tour & Tabernacle tour

October 1, 2027 (Friday)

Our day begins with what our guests have been waiting for- a tour of the newly renovated Salt Lake Temple. After our tour we will have a tour have Temple Square and the Tabernacle. After lunch on your own, we will meet at the Beehive House for a tour. Our journey together will end at the Joseph Smith Memorial Building for a tour and dinner together with a special guest speaker. Guest that are non-U.S. residents: Zion National Park charges an extra \$100 fee per person. This is not included and will be added to your invoice.

Pricing:

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- \$2850 per person, based on double occupancy

- \$2745 per person based on triple occupancy

- \$2595 per person based on quad occupancy

- \$3680 single occupancy rate

Tips

Several of you have asked about the tipping for the bus driver and guide. This is done at the end of each leg the tour (anytime during the last day per bus driver).

â€¢ Driver: A tip is required for the driver and we recommend the amount of \$30 per person for the tour

â€¢ LDS Guide: This tip is not required; but it is appreciated. If you feel they did a good job and would like to thank them, this is the perfect way to do so.

Payment Schedule

- \$250 per person due at time of booking
- Final Payment: Final payment is due three months before the tour departure date.

Cancellation Policy

Bountiful Travel recommends the purchase of travel insurance to help avoid loss of your travel expenses due to cancellations.

If Bountiful Travel cancels the tour: We will refund all deposits and any other payments unless the tour is canceled due to a pandemic or civil unrest.

If Bountiful Travel cancels due to a pandemic or civil unrest: The deposit is non-refundable. However, the deposit is transferable to a future tour. The balance will be refunded.

If guest cancels for any reason â€” The following terms apply

Booking Date to 6 Months Prior to Tour

- Deposits may be refunded or transferred only if we are able to fill the cancelled spot.
- If the spot is filled, the deposit may be:
 - Refunded or
 - Transferred as a credit to a future tour.

3 to 6 Months Prior to Tour

- Deposits are non-refundable.
- Deposit credit may be transferred to a future tour only if we are able to fill the cancelled spot.

30 Days to 3 Months Prior to Tour

- All tour costs are non-refundable.
- Tour payments may be transferred to a new participant on the same reservation and on the same tour, subject to our approval. Fees may be assessed if this change is allowed.

30 Days or Less Prior to Tour (Including Tour Start Date)

- All tour costs are non-refundable and non-transferable.

A minimum number of 29 passengers is needed for this tour to depart

Check Your Invoice Names: Please check to see that your names are spelled correctly. Your first and last names must appear as they appear on your passport for International travel and Driver's License for domestic tours.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Due to the nature of this tour you must be able to climb stairs and walk unassisted at a moderate pace 3-5 miles per day. No walking aids are allowed (wheel chairs, rollators, scooters, etc.).

Please note that minor changes to the itinerary may occur due to local conditions and to better accommodate our group.
