

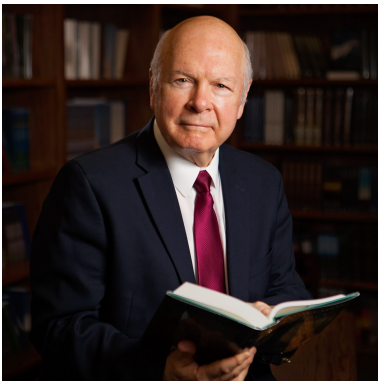
CANADA AT ITS FINEST FALL FOLIAGE

Day 4: Sydney, NS

October 16, 2023

October 18, 2023

Day 7: Bar Harbor, MA

October 19, 2023
