Itinerary:

Day 1: Rome, Italy

September 17, 2024 (Tuesday)

Our first day in Rome! We will start the day with a quick group and then head into the heart of the city. Today we will start at the gates of the city at Piazza del Popolo. From here we will walk to the famous Spanish Steps and take in the crowds on the stairs. From here we head to Trevi Fountain and throw a coin in to ensure or return to Rome one day. Day 7: Villages of Manarola, Riomaggiore, and Vernazza
