Day 1: Depart from Home

December 19, 2026 (Saturday)

Depart from the US to Cairo.

Day 2: Arrive in Egypt

December 20, 2026 (Sunday)

Arrive in Cairo. We will be met at the airport and driven to our hotel where we can relax and enjoy our

evening on our own. Overnight in Cairo.

Day 3: Pyramids of Giza - Grand Egyptian Museum

December 21, 2026 (Monday)

Today we head to the Giza Plateau and marvel at one of the Seven Wonders of the Worlds, the Great Pyramids of Giza. We visit the Sphinx and Valley Temple. Following lunch, we go to the Grand Egyptian Museum. The museum houses the archaeological finds from the Giza area. Following these experiences, we head back to our hotel. Overnight in Cairo (B,L)

Day 4: Aswan - 3-Day Nile River Cruise

December 22, 2026 (Tuesday)

We check out of our hotel and transfer to the airport for our flight to Aswan. We visit the Philae Temple and the Unfinished Obelisk. Overnight in Aswan (B)

Day 5: Abu Simbel

December 23, 2026 (Wednesday)

Check out of you hotel and set off for the Temples of Abu Simbel. These temples are considered the masterpieces of ancient Egypt. They were constructed by Ramses II as monuments to the Gods. Following our visit to to the Temples of Abu Simbel, we head to the Nile rive and board our luxurious cruise ship. (B,L,D)

Day 6: Kom Ombo - Edfu - Nile River Cruise

December 24, 2026 (Thursday)

We start our cruise sailing north. Our first stop is at Kom Ombo to visit the only double temple in Egypt, which is dedicated to Horus the falcon and Sobek the crocodile. We return to the ship and continue on to Edfu. There we find the most complete temple in Egypt. Overnight onboard near Esna. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Luxor - Valley of the Kings - Colossi of Memnon

December 25, 2026 (Friday)

We head to the West Bank and see the Valley of the Kings, the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut and the Colossi of Memnon. We have some free time in Luxor for shopping, before we return to our boat for dinner. Overnight onboard. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Karnak & Luxor Temples - Fly from Luxor to Cairo

December 26, 2026 (Saturday)

We enjoy a final breakfast onboard and then we disembark. We visit the ancient Karnak and Luxor Temples. We transfer to the Luxor Airport for our flight back to Cairo. In Cairo we are transferred to our hotel and we have the evening to ourselves. Overnight in Cairo. (B)

Day 9: Cairo - Flight to Tel Aviv

December 27, 2026 (Sunday)

We enjoy breakfast at the hotel then load our luggage onto the coach. We have some free time to explore the streets of Cairo. We are transferred to the Cairo International Airport for our flight to Tel Aviv. (B)

- If you cancel before final payment due date: Deposit is refundable or transferable as long as we (or you) can fill your spots. After final payment, the full amount is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- If Bountiful Travel cancels the tour: We will refund all deposits and any other payments unless the tour is canceled due to a pandemic or civil unrest.
- If Bountiful Travel cancels due to a pandemic or civil unrest: The deposit is non-refundable. However, the deposit is transferable to a future tour. The balance will be refunded.
- No changes can be made to land tour bookings within 30 days of tour departure date, including name changes.

Check Your Invoice Names: Please check to see that your names are spelled correctly. Your first and last names must appear as they appear on your passport for International travel and Driver's License for domestic tours.
