Itinerary:

Day 1: Depart from Home

March 20, 2027 (Saturday)

If you did not sign up with Bountiful Travel for Brent Top's or Camille Fronk Olson's Israel tour, depart from the US to Cairo.

Day 2: Arrive in Egypt

March 21, 2027 (Sunday)

Arrive in Cairo. We will be met at the airport and driven to our hotel where we can relax and enjoy our evening on our own. Overnight in Cairo.

Day 3: Fly to Luxor - 3-day Nile River Cruise - East Bank Sightseeing

March 22, 2027 (Monday)

We check out of our Cairo hotel and head to the airport for our flight to Luxor and our 3-day Nile River cruise. We board our vessel for our luxurious cruise. Lunch is onboard the ship. We see both the Karnak and the Luxor Temples on the East Bank before returning to our cruise ship. Overnight onboard. (B, L, D)

Day 4: West Bank Sightseeing

March 23, 2027 (Tuesday)

We head to the West Bank and see the Valley of the Kings, the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut and the Colossi of Memnon. We have some free time in Luxor for shopping, before we return to our boat for dinner. Overnight onboard. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Kom Ombo - Edfu - Nile River Cruise

March 24, 2027 (Wednesday)

We continue our cruise. We visit Edfu. There we find the most complete temple in Egypt. We reboard our ship and sail to Kom Ombo to visit the only double temple in Egypt, which is dedicated to Horus the falcon and Sobek the crocodile. Overnight onboard. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Aswan

March 25, 2027 (Thursday)

We spend the day exploring Aswan. We visit the massive unfinished obelisk. We also visit the Temple of Philae, devoted to the goddesses Isis and Hathor. Following these visits, we return to our cruise ship. Overnight onboard (B,L,D)

Day 7: Abu Simbe - Fly from Aswan to Cairo

March 26, 2027 (Friday)

We enjoy a final breakfast onboard and then we disembark. Before leaving for the Aswan Airport we visit Abu Simbel home of the temples of Ramses II and Queen Nefertari. We transfer to the Aswan Airport for our flight back to Cairo. In Cairo we are transferred to our hotel and we have the evening to ourselves. Overnight in Cairo. (B,L)

Day 8: Pyramids of Giza - Grand Egyptian Museum

March 27, 2027 (Saturday)

Today we head to the Giza Plateau and marvel at one of the Seven Wonders of the Worlds, the Great

Pyramids of Giza. We visit the Sphinx and Valley Temple. Following lunch, we go to the Grand Egyptian Museum. The museum houses the archaeological finds from the Giza area. Following these experiences, we head to the Cairo airport for our late evening flights home. (B,L)

Price

Payment Schedule

- \$500 per person due at time of booking. The deposit is non-refundable unless either you or Bountiful Travel can find someone to fill your spot.
- Final Payment: Final payment is due three months before the tour departure date.

Deposit & Cancellation Policy

Booking Date to 6 Months Prior to Tour

- Deposits are non-refundable.
- Deposits may be refunded or transferred only if we are able to fill the cancelled spot.
- If the spot is filled, the deposit may be:
 - Refunded, or
 - Transferred as a credit to a future tour.

3 to 6 Months Prior to Tour

- Deposits are non-refundable.
- Deposit credit may be transferred to a future tour only if we are able to fill the cancelled spot.

30 Days to 3 Months Prior to Tour

- Tour costs are non-refundable.
- Deposit credit may be transferred to a new participant for the same tour, subject to our approval.

30 Days or Less Prior to Tour (Including Tour Start Date)

- All tour costs are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Travel Insurance Recommendation

We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance to protect against loss of non-refundable tour costs in the event you need to cancel your trip.

Check Your Invoice Names: Please check to see that your names are spelled correctly. Your first and last names must appear as they appear on your passport for International travel and Driver's License for domestic tours.

PASSPORTS ARE REQUIRED and should be valid 6 months after the end of the tour.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Due to the nature of this tour you must be able to climb stairs and walk unassisted at a moderate pace.
